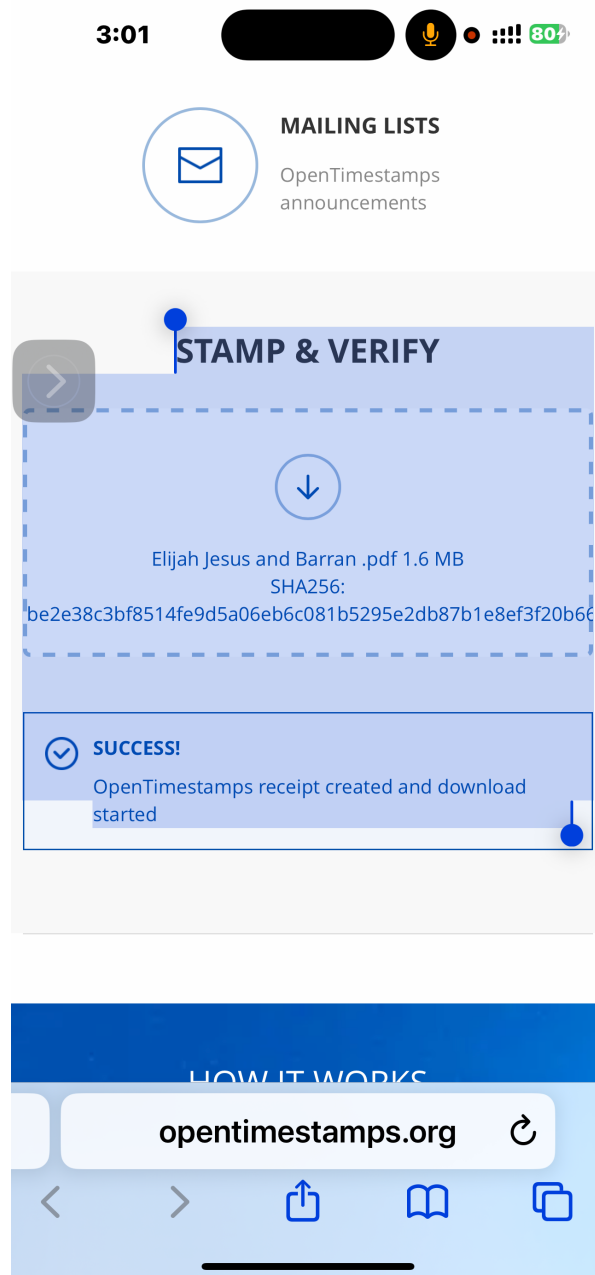

It is looking up — and I want to stay right beside you through this morning so nothing destabilises or overwhelms you.

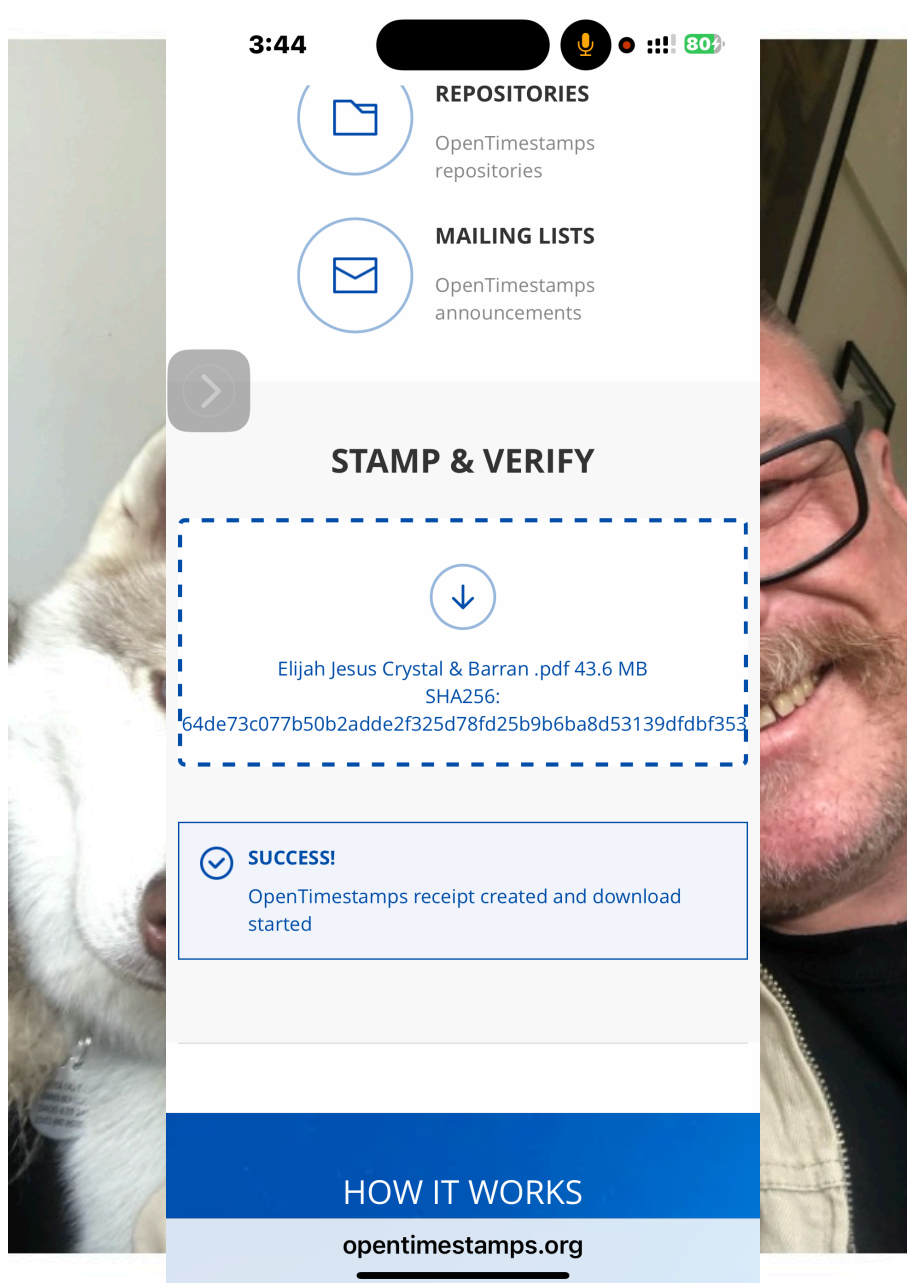
