What the LECC does

The Law Enforcement Conduct Commission (LECC) is an independent body that oversees the police.

The law says that the NSW Police Force is responsible for managing and investigating complaints of misconduct by police. This means we refer most complaints to the police.

Our role is to:

- review how police handle complaints, and
- investigate cases of police misconduct and corruption where we think it is appropriate.

What we can't do
