Outcome of your review

We have made a decision about how you can contact us.

In making this decision, I considered:

- Your current circumstances.
- Your behavior at Tuggeranong Service Centre on 6 March 2025.

What this means for you

From **20 March 2025 to 31 July 2025**, you can contact Vijaya. They will help you with referrals, and information about our services. You can only contact us by:

- calling **1800 312 004 and choosing option 2**. You will be connected to **Vijaya** and they will assist you. If they are not there, you will be connected to **Ardin**.

This means from **20 March 2025 to 31 July 2025**, you cannot:

- enter any Services Australia premises or places in which Centrelink, Medicare and/or Child Support services are offered, or
- enter any associated carparks provided for the use of persons attending for Centrelink, Medicare and/or Child Support services.

If you enter any Services Australia premises, places or associated carparks without an agreed appointment, **the police may be called and you may be prosecuted for criminal trespass.**

This restriction applies if you enter the premises, place or associated carpark, regardless of anything that a Services Australia employee may say or do at the time you enter the premises place or associated carpark.

You can contact Vijaya and they will explain the decision. After receiving an explanation, you can ask that we reconsider the decision.

We may share details of your restricted contact arrangement with other government departments as required.

We will review this arrangement by **31 July 2025** and will contact you again to tell you about the outcome.

Reminder about your behaviour

We all deserve to feel safe and to be treated with respect.

When you contact us, you can expect our staff to provide a respectful service.
