You will need to present to your local housing office one or more of the following: • an L17 referral from police • an Intervention Order or an Interim Intervention Order (State), or an application for one of these • an integrated assessment such as the Common Risk Assessment Framework that identifies family violence • a Family Court Restraining Order (Federal) • a letter from a solicitor stating that criminal proceedings have started against the alleged respondent of violence • a letter from a medical practitioner • a letter from a designated service provider • a VCAT order or written confirmation of relinquishment of tenancy due to an exclusion condition.
Richard Mclean	Supporting Documentation - Support letter	If you are unable to commence legal proceedings because it would place you at further risk, a letter from a medical practitioner, solicitor or a community support worker who provides support services to persons experiencing family violence, is required to confirm that you are experiencing emotional, sexual or physical violence, the reason you are unable to take legal action, and details of your current housing circumstances.
Richard Mclean	Supporting Documentation - Other	AND/OR A written report from a member of Victoria Police or Federal Police detailing Police involvement in the situation, and confirmation that the household or a member of the household is under serious threat of physical danger. If you believe that the involvement of the Police would place you or your family under further threat of physical danger, a report is required from a Community Support Worker such as a Local Government Family Support Worker, a Social Worker from a Community Health Centre, Koori or Migrant Resource

		Centre or similar service. The report must include circumstances that have placed the household under serious threat of physical danger, and reasons why the Police cannot resolve the problem. Richard Mclean	Letter -	Also, we require a written documentation from an Initial Assessment and Planning Worker (IAP Worker) confirming your current housing circumstances. The IAP Worker will also need to confirm that you have approached their service to seek assistance with securing alternative accommodation, if they were able or unable to assist you and provide details or a brief explanation of your attempts at securing alternative private rental accommodation or why private rental accommodation is not an option for you. If you are not already linked in with a support agency, please contact the crisis hotline number as the first point of contact for assistance on 1800 825 955.
