We have received your application for review of the decision made by the Department of Social Services. You are asking us to review a decision about a Public Interest Disclosure (PID) assessment made under the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2013* (PID Act).

Can we review this decision?

We can only review this decision if a Commonwealth law says that we can.

We cannot find any law that says you can make an application to us about the decision.

It therefore seems that we cannot review your decision.

What happens next?

If you think we can review your decision, please contact us within 14 days after receiving this letter and tell us why.

If you cannot show that we can review the decision, we can dismiss your application. This means we will not review it.

We might hold a hearing to decide if we can review your decision. If we hold a hearing, we will let you know the date and time and where it will be. You can represent yourself at the hearing or arrange for someone else to represent you.

Why do we collect information and what do we do with it?

We collect information from you to process and consider your application under the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975*.

If we decide to hold a hearing, we will give information about your application to the respondent.

Limited information about a case is usually made available to the public on request and can be accessed using *eCase Search* on our website. This information includes the names of the parties and any representatives, the type of application, dates of case events, the types of key documents given to us and the outcome of the application. Information about a case is usually first made available on *eCase Search* 7 days after we receive the application.

More information is usually made publicly available if we hold a hearing and make a decision in the case. Our hearings are usually open to the public, and most of our decisions are published on the internet.

We can order that information be kept confidential if we believe there is good reason to do so. You can apply for an order by writing to us stating what you want kept confidential and why. In some cases, legislation requires that information be kept confidential.

Our Privacy Policy tells you how you can access and seek correction of personal information we hold about you, how to make a complaint about the way we have handled your personal information and how we will deal with such a complaint.
