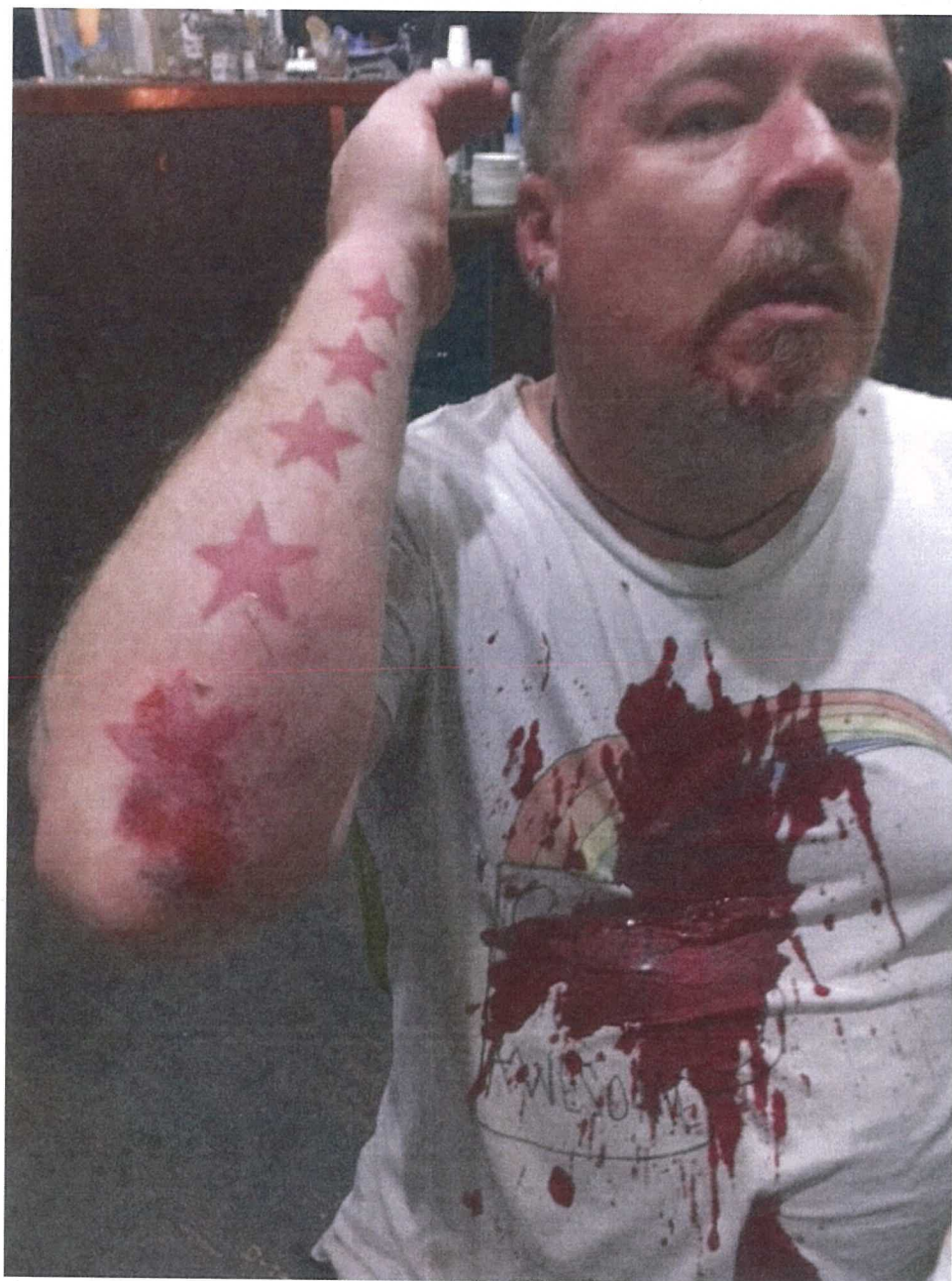

McLEAN claims that the Dr was dismissive and should have taken better care. The Dr then prescribed some opioids to McLEAN that McLEAN later used in trying to OD. McLEAN survived the OD and later wrote to the Australian Health Practitioners Regulation Agency (AHPRA), with the evidence of 'malpractice' by Dr McLEAN also stated that he had an audio recording of the conversation with the Dr. which he ^{said he} would provide to me via email. At this point I asked for all of the information that McLEAN could provide, and he gave me the Response letter from AHPRA, the written transcript of the audio recording he took, 2 x stat decs from his friends about his suicidal state during that period, and the suicide note he wrote on 24/9/18. as well as a copy of an email he sent to a generic footscray police email address on 27/12/19, which he had obtained from the footscray police web site. I asked McLEAN if he needed immediate mental health assistance, and he stated that he was doing ok now and had been seeing new health professionals. He said he was in a much better place and did not need to go to the hospital today, but that he was only chasing up the 'malpractice' allegations with police today because he was not satisfied

with the response from AHPRA, which stated that the Dr had not done anything wrong. I told MCLEAN that I would listen to his recording and that I would contact AHPRA to ask for their side of the story. To this MCLEAN seemed satisfied and was about to leave but before he left I again double checked if he needed any mental health assistance and MCLEAN again assured me that he was going OK today and declined any immediate assistance. I explained that there would be no harm in submitting referrals, to which he accepted and provided his phone number. I was satisfied with this as MCLEAN presented to me as well spoken and level headed, he did not appear to be in any distress or mention any mental health concerns that were affecting him at this time. I also spoke to DSC [redacted] 33(1) who told me that based on the letter from AHPRA there was no real evidence of malpractice but that I could speak to them for more information. He also stated that it did not constitute a criminal offence and was not a police matter but rather an internal investigation for AHPRA.
