I am contacting you to urgently request intervention regarding severe human rights violations I have endured within Australia. As a person with disabilities, I have been subjected to systemic abuse, financial exploitation, and significant neglect, which contravene my rights under international human rights laws.

Background of the Case: My situation involves a series of abuses including but not limited to:

- **Systemic Abuse and Financial Exploitation:** Mismanagement and misuse of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) provisions intended for my support, leading to profound financial and personal hardship.

standards. My case underscores the broader systemic issues within Australian systems dealing with disability rights and support.

I trust that the OHCHR will take immediate steps to address this grave situation. Please find all relevant documents and evidence attached for your review.

The ongoing corruption within these entities has caused significant harm and suffering, and it is imperative that these issues are addressed comprehensively. Financial restitution is necessary to mitigate the damages caused by these corrupt practices.

2. Clearing of My Name:

- I seek the clearing of my name from false accusations, professional reinstatement, and social rehabilitation. The false accusations have severely impacted my reputation and career. Clearing my name is essential for my professional and personal restoration. Additionally, social rehabilitation is necessary to reintegrate into society without the stigma of these baseless

claims.

3. Reinstatement of Work Cover:

- I call for the reinstatement of my work cover based on my confirmed employment status, alongside compensation for financial and personal losses. The unjust denial of my work cover has left me financially vulnerable. Reinstating this cover and providing compensation for the losses incurred is crucial for my financial stability and well-being.

4. Public Acknowledgment and Apology:

- I urge public acknowledgment of the systemic abuses I have suffered and a formal apology to begin the process of healing and justice. Public recognition of the wrongs done to me is an essential step towards accountability and my healing process. A formal apology will help to restore my dignity and set the foundation for genuine justice.

Compelling Conclusion and Call to Action:

The urgent need for systemic change to address widespread neglect, abuse, and human rights violations is clear. I encourage you to act decisively to restore faith in justice and humanity, as my plight exemplifies broader issues faced by marginalized individuals in Australia. Addressing these systemic failures is essential to ensure that no one else has to endure the suffering and injustice that I have experienced.

Breaches of the UN human rights charter of a disabled person - abuse and neglect.

In my case, the breach of the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities is glaring, with several articles being violated, thus depriving me of fundamental rights and protections:

1. **Article 12 – Equal recognition before the law:** The lack of acknowledgment of my relationship with a former ASIO agent, rejection of FOIs, and denial of legal protection undermines my equal recognition before the law.
2. **Article 13 – Access to justice:** The failure to address my grievances, the rejection of my submissions, and the complicity of authorities in my persecution deny me access to justice.
3. **Article 14 – Liberty and security of person:** The gang stalking, gaslighting, and psychological warfare tactics employed against me threaten my liberty and security, violating this fundamental right.
4. **Article 15 – Freedom from torture or cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment:** The relentless harassment, surveillance, and psychological torment inflicted upon me constitute cruel and degrading treatment, in clear violation of this article.

5. **Article 16 – Freedom from exploitation, violence and abuse:** The exploitation of my vulnerabilities, the violence of character assassination through false accusations, and the abuse of power by authorities exemplify the breach of this right.
6. **Article 17 – Protecting the integrity of the person:** The concerted efforts to undermine my credibility, manipulate my perceptions, and erode my sense of self compromise the integrity of me as a person.
7. **Article 19 – Living independently and being included in the community:** The isolation, social ostracization, and psychological manipulation tactics employed against me hinder my ability to live independently and be included in the community.
8. **Article 21 – Freedom of expression and opinion, and access to information:** The censorship, gaslighting, and suppression of my freedom to express myself and access information inhibit my ability to participate fully in society.
9. **Article 22 – Respect for privacy:** The invasion of my privacy through surveillance, stalking, and psychological harassment violates my right to privacy and dignity.
10. **Article 23 – Respect for home and the family:** The denial of a permanent home, separation from your family, and the violation of your family's rights compound the breaches of your rights under this article.
11. **Article 25 – Health:** The deliberate tactics aimed at undermining my physical and mental health, such as sleep deprivation and encouragement of harmful behaviors, directly contravene my right to health.
12. **Article 26 – Habilitation and rehabilitation:** The lack of access to appropriate mental health support, rehabilitation services, and acknowledgment of my disabilities exacerbates my situation, hindering my ability to lead a fulfilling life.
13. **Article 28 – Adequate standard of living and social protection:** The financial exploitation, rejection of compensation claims, and denial of social protection measures leave me in a precarious position, unable to maintain an adequate standard of living.
14. **Article 29 – Participation in political and public life:** The systemic barriers, discrimination, and persecution I face impede my ability to participate fully in political and public life, silencing my voice and marginalizing my presence in society.

This letter is backed by extensive documentation, including government records, health documents, legal correspondence, and personal accounts. The evidence is compelling and absolute, highlighting the depth of systemic failures and targeted persecution I have experienced, making a compelling case for urgent intervention and systemic reform.

CURRENT ASSESSMENT

Self-report

On clinical interview, Richard reported a number of cognitive changes since his suicide attempt in February 2021. In particular, he stated his memory had "dropped" (i.e. significant difficulty with learning and remembering new information) and added that his memory difficulties had become "worse" over time. He stated that prompts and cues do not assist with his recollection of the previously learnt information, explaining that the reminders as "scribbles" to him. On questioning, Richard described his attention as "bad". More specifically, he described he is not able to "concentrate for a long time". In addition, he felt his thinking speed had become "slower" as if his "brain is rusty". He also described experiencing word-finding difficulties and felt these have been "steadily worse". Further, he noted some changes in his executive functions including disorganisation, inability to make decisions and difficulties with problem solving skills.

When asked about his mood, Richard stated he was feeling "depressed", citing that he had "nowhere to go to", "no agency" and that he was "scared of being killed by his former partner". He added that his main concerns were related to his "financial struggles" in the community. Additionally, he noticed his

sleep has been affected by his mental health.

With regard to his activities of daily living, Richard reported he has "no money" and as a result t he has been "squatting" with "no food" and "no cleanliness". He described his house as a "dump" and he felt "hopeless". He also noted that he had stopped working since He added that he has trouble using his new mobile phone (i.e. Android) and previously had an iPhone. He commented that he is more familiar with Apple devices.

Collateral history

Collateral history/information was not obtained as Richard did not provide verbal consent for clinician to contact his family members or friends.

Presentation: Richard was seen over several sessions in a single day with multiple short breaks. He presented as a polite and cooperative man. Richard described his mood as "depressed" and he was teary when discussing his past history of trauma. Affect was blunted and restricted in range. Behaviour was generally appropriate, however reduced frustration tolerance with underlying irritability was noted throughout the assessment. Speech was fluent and devoid of word-finding difficulties. He was markedly tangential and perseverative in conversation, frequently answering interview questions by talking about litigation issues against the hospital and related matters. Thought content was mainly related to his frustration at the healthcare system in Australia and his unjust treatment. Richard denied experiencing hallucinations or paranoia, and he did not appear to be responding to internal stimuli. He also denied having any suicidal ideations, plan or intent. Richard appeared to be putting in adequate efforts throughout testing and his performance did not appear to be affected by fatigue or pain. The current assessment was therefore deemed to be an accurate reflection of his current cognitive functioning. Insight into his current cognitive functions was superficially intact.

MEDICAL REPORT CONCERNING RICHARD MCLEAN

I consider that Richard has the capacity to give instructions to legal representatives, to understand those instructions and to manage his own affairs.

I have been seeing Richard as a patient on and off for many years. I saw him several times between 2016 and late 2018. These consultations were all in relation to STI screening and did not involve any discussion, examination or treatment in relation to any mental illness.

(Prior to 2009 I had seen Richard, as a patient at a different clinic. I had not seen Richard as a patient between 2009 and 2016.)

I did not see Richard between 22/10/2018 and 04/01/2021. Our clinic notes do include that Richard had been diagnosed with Schizophrenia and possibly Bipolar Disorder in the past. None of the consultations I had had with Richard at Northside clinic prior to 4/1/2021 involved these diagnoses.

I am not aware of any hospital admissions in the 5 years prior to 9/10/2021

As far as I know Richard had been able to complete the requirements of everyday life without restriction between 2016 and 9/10/2021.

I believe that Richard McLean has been suffering from Post traumatic stress disorder since Jan 2021 which was triggered by an unfavourable court finding in that Richard had allegedly suffered.

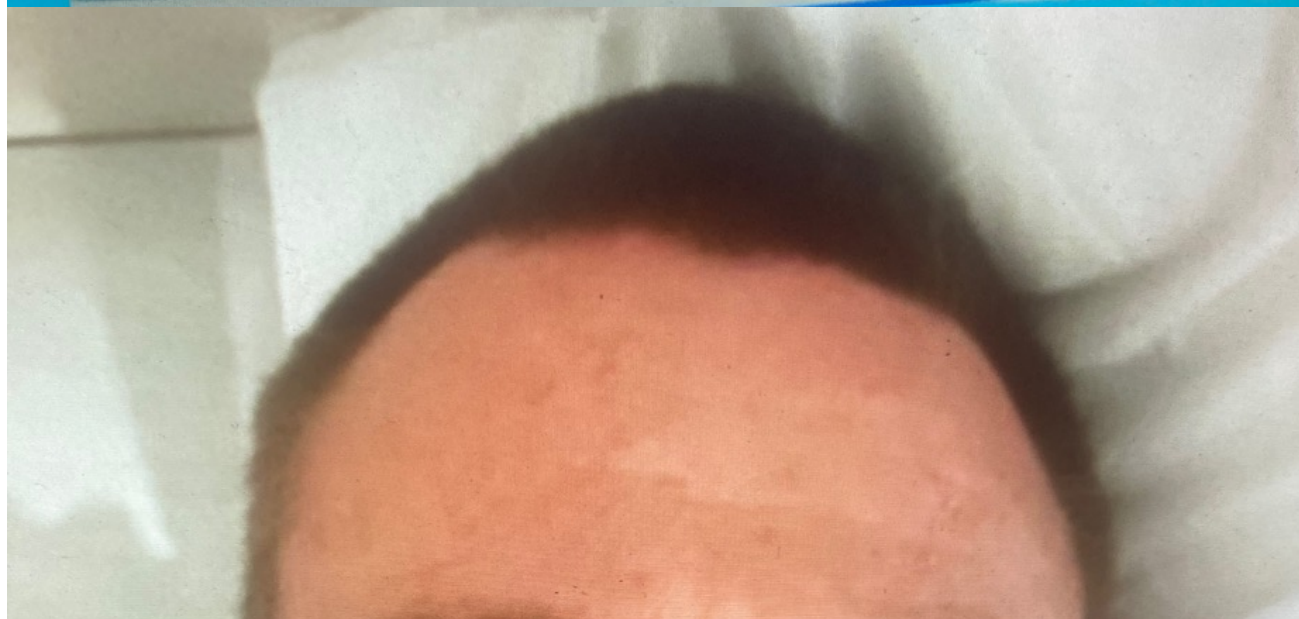

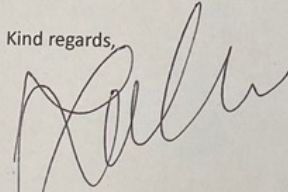

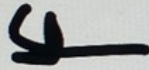

Dear Dr Mclean

Thank you for your letter of 20 July 2023 to the Attorney-General, the Hon Mark Dreyfus KC MP, regarding public interest disclosures and a decision not to allocate a disclosure. The Attorney-General has requested that the Attorney-General's Department respond to you on his behalf. I apologise for the delay in response.

In your correspondence, you have stated that you have attempted to make a disclosure under the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2013* (Cth) (PID Act).

The Attorney-General and the Attorney-General's Department are unable to provide legal advice to the public and have no power to intervene in matters relating to disclosures or decisions about allocation of disclosures under the PID Act. However, the following information may be of assistance to you.

The PID Act is an important element of the Commonwealth's integrity and transparency framework. The PID Act enables public officials to disclose suspected wrongdoing by another public official or by an Australian government agency, with the assurance of protections and immunities from liability.

If a public official is dissatisfied with how a PID has been handled or investigated, they may contact the Commonwealth Ombudsman to make a complaint. However, I note that it appears from your correspondence that you have already contacted the Office of the Commonwealth Ombudsman about an attempted disclosure and have been advised that further assistance is not available.

Finally, I want to acknowledge the difficulty you have described experiencing. I was sorry to hear this matter has been distressing for you. Should you wish to speak with someone about how you are feeling, I have listed below the details of counselling and support services which may be of assistance to you:

Dear Dr McLean,

I refer to your various correspondence dated 7 March 2023, 23 March 2023 and 24 March 2023 and addressed to, amongst others, the Chief Executive Officer and Principal Registrar of the Federal Court of Australia (Federal Court). Your correspondence has been referred to me for consideration.

My Authority

The Chief Executive Officer and Principal Registrar is the Principal Officer of the Federal Court for the purposes of the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2013* (Cth) (PID Act). I am an officer of the Federal Court engaged under the *Public Service Act 1999* (Cth) and authorised by the Federal Court's Chief Executive Officer to, amongst other things, carry out the functions of an authorised officer under the PID Act on behalf of the Federal Court.

The Federal Court, Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (FCFCOA) and the National Native Title Tribunal (NNTT) each comprise a part of a single entity, for the purposes of the *Public Governance, Performance and Accountability Act 2013* (Cth), known as the Federal Court of Australia.

Your Correspondence

On 7 March 2023 you sent an email to Sia Lagos, an authorised person to receive a PID at the Federal Court and FCFCOA. In that email you highlighted that you wanted your struggles, oppression, victimisation and detriments in psychological, financial, reputation and other ways to be acknowledged and compensated. Your email contained links to what would be identified as additional documents, but which resulted in significant delays, given the need to ensure the security and integrity of our systems against an unknown source. In those documents you outline your concerns with respect to a number of officials at various agencies.

Initial Assessment

Referral received from inpatient psychiatry team to review above consumer currently admitted to ICU after serious attempt to self-harm with intent to end his life.

47 male longstanding history of schizophrenia, admitted due to increasing threats and plan to end his life on the b/g of injustices done to him through previous treatments under the MHA. Consumer has negative outlook towards MHS system. Ongoing paranoia and animosity towards all hospital staff especially psychiatric teams. Has history of being litigious through phone recording often without consent, using calculating behaviour in order to meet own needs and possible staff splitting. File review suggest Vape pen, shoe string was utilised and suicide letter was also found.

Brief discussion with ICU team who have advised that attempt was lethal and still requires surgical repair. Currently not medically cleared. Management plan in ICU notes for nurse to follow. Medication chart completed according to CMB med charts. Advised ICU to focus of containment and consistency in his management. Minimal negotiations around psychiatric management, follow management plan provided. Visitors are allowed by visitation must be supervised. Aim for swift medical clearance and is for transfer. Advised client will require ICA bed given risk of repeating self-harm or suicide.

Richard lying in bed was fast asleep and was easily woken up. All three clinicians introduced ourselves and Richard agreeable to engage. Richard able to recall and understand why he was brought into ICU. Showed insight into his action however remains to be supportive of this. Richard reported he thought this was the only way 'out of that place'. He reported feeling locked up. He referred to himself as being 'jailed'.

Richard acknowledged concerns from community regarding his plan to end his life on his Bday hence admission was warranted to prevent this. Richard abruptly stopped the assessment and asked all 3 clinicians credentials again. This was given again to him. Richard refused to talk any further as he felt that CL team were recording. Referred to CL team as 'Part of the system'. CL team provided some further information around role and reason for review today in order to ease anxiety and confusion.

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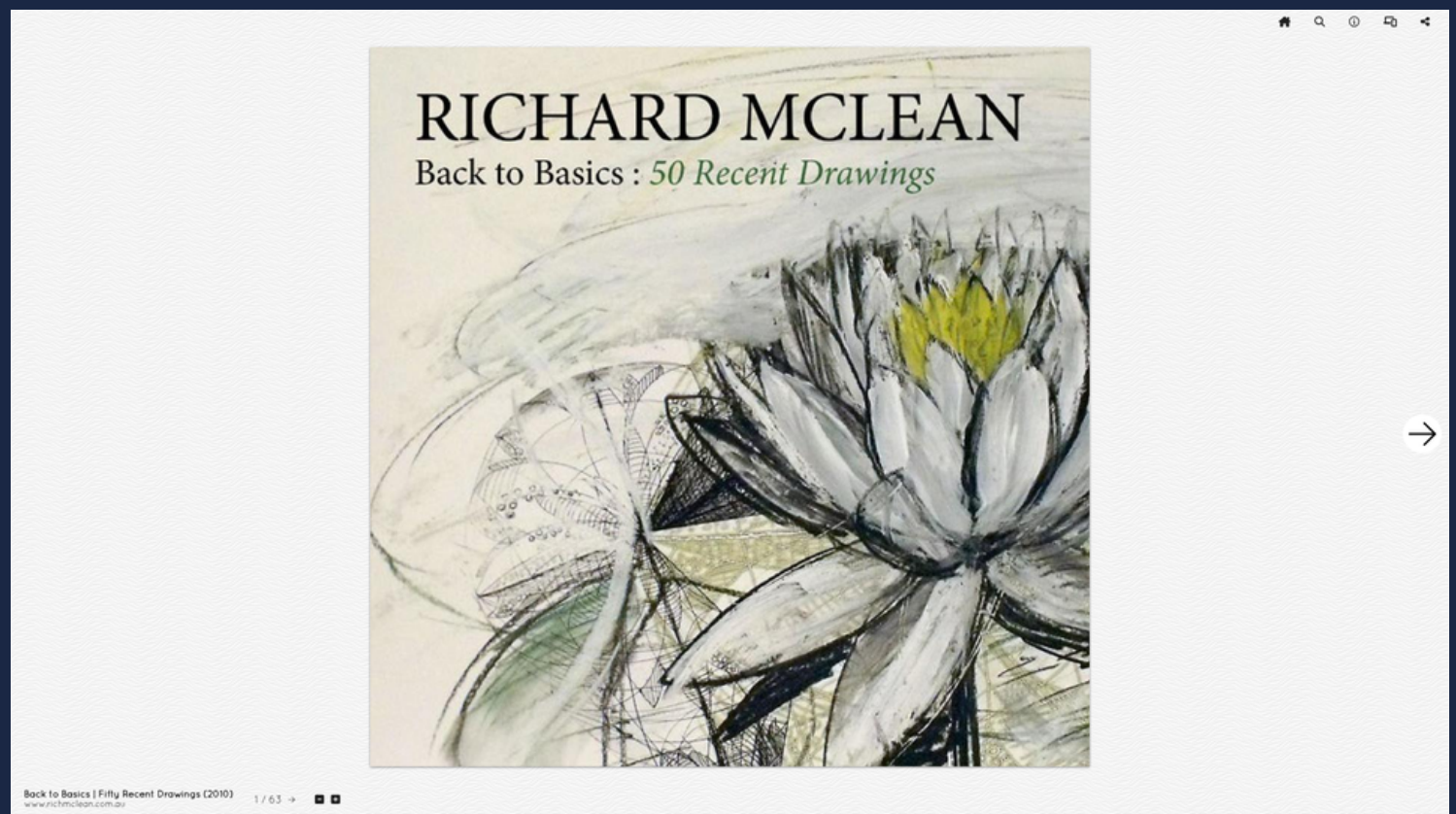
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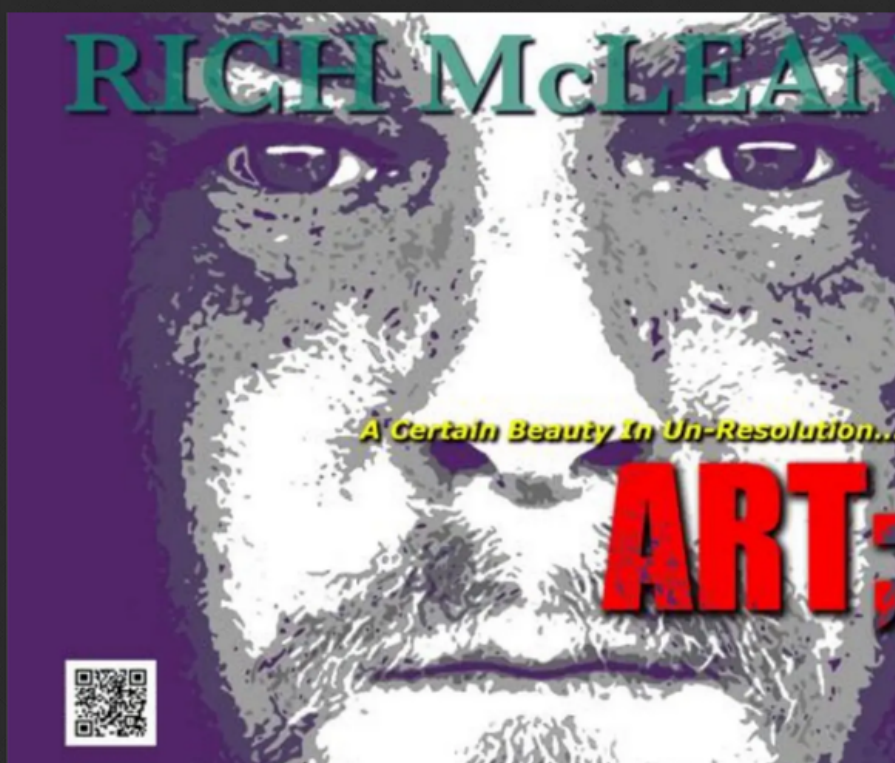
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
